2015 CONVENTION REPORT – The directors reviewed the convention report presented by Chairman Ed Harmon and thanked North Road Combine for hosting the convention.

2016 CONVENTION REPORT – Chairman Darryl Coston said 272 pigeons currently are in the loft and doing well. 1 bird is missing during loft exercise. The convention will be held November 3-6 at the Hotel Rosedale (directly behind the Doubletree) in Bakersfield. Everything will be held at the hotel except the race. STATE RACE LOFT – 2016 Loft Manager Darryl Coston said a one-ton truck with a flatbed is ideal to move the loft. The second loft axle should be replaced with one that has brakes. Darryl will get a cost estimate on replacing the axle and obtaining a regular trailer license. The Board authorized cashing in our CD to pay for this if necessary. Darryl also noted that the loft extension is not occupied by the birds during very hot conditions; they go on the floor in the main section instead. He recommends we change the roof design if more pigeons are accepted. Based upon these observations, Darryl recommends changing the State Race Rules so no more than 225 birds are placed in the State Race loft. Brazil moved, Severns seconded, and it was unanimously approved that we change the State Race rules starting 2017 to maximum 225 birds if the State Race Loft is used.

DONATIONS – It was moved by Brazil, seconded by Severns and unanimously approved that we donate \$1000 to the Ladies' Auxiliary Scholarship Fund and donate \$500 to the City of Hope's Fly For Hope program.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:28.
