

**CALIFORNIA STATE RACING PIGEON ORGANIZATION  
BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING 02-11-2018**

The meeting was called to order at 10:20am at Brooks Ranch Restaurant in Fresno. Present: Severns, Ortega, Dias, Meder, Coston, Gonigan, Barger, Stierlin. Guests: Barbara Coston, Shirley Severns.

**OFFICERS' REPORTS:**

North VP Manny Dias: No ordinance problems in his section.

President Ex-Officio Frank Meder: 2 flyers in Roseville (near Sacramento) have been told to curtail flying. Must limit birds on their property to 10. Working with city officials to revise ordinance or obtain a variance.

Central VP Ramon Ortega: Bakersfield Club had their winter show with great turnout. No ordinance problems in his section.

South VP Bill Barger: 4 new members.

Judges/Awards Chairman Mike Gonigan: No apps were received for Disney Awards. He proposed that we limit the Disney to one award per year, with no separate categories for number of lofts competing. It was moved by Meder/Coston that we accept this proposal, beginning with the 2018 award. It was approved unanimously.

Mike also proposed that we add four new Champion Loft awards similar to the AU Champion Loft. It was moved by Coston/Ortega that we accept this proposal, beginning with the 2018 awards. It was approved unanimously.

Secretary-Treasurer Joyce Stierlin noted that award plaques are one of our largest annual expenses. To accommodate additional awards she suggested we prepare one perpetual plaque per Hall of Fame or Champion Loft winning flyer. Then we would issue engraved plates for each of their HOF birds or Champion Loft wins to put on the flyer's perpetual plaque. It was moved by Barger/Meder that starting with the 2017 awards if this method costs less than we have been paying for individual bird plaques we will use the new method. It was approved unanimously.

Mike purchased a security box to hold the original State Show winner's belt buckle. He will revise the State Show rules and entry sheet to indicate the winner must have flown in the award year. Also he will refine the judges' test. Several new judges currently are under consideration.

Mike announced the 2017 CSRPO Hall of Fame awards. First place winners who are members of CSRPO will receive plaques and Mike will make award certificates for CSRPO members who achieved 2<sup>nd</sup> through 10<sup>th</sup> place in each category. He will contact each first place winner.

**2018 CONVENTION REPORT** – Terry Arnold will be State Race loft manager this year. They will take 225 birds maximum. Bakersfield Club has opted to do the 3-day convention Nov 2-4 at the Hotel Rosedale, with Friday night shipping and the California State Race (weather permitting), Annual Meeting and Awards Banquet on Saturday.

The AU has offered to partner with CSRPO for convention activities as a mini-AU convention if locals will do the race, and perhaps we could add an AU Zone Meeting to the CSRPO Convention schedule. AU Executive Director Karen Clifton will be invited to our CSRPO Board breakfast meeting at the convention in November to discuss this possibility.

**DONATIONS:** Dias/Gonigan moved that we donate \$1000 to the Ladies' Auxiliary Scholarship Fund and \$500 to the City of Hope. It was approved unanimously.
