Official Application for Annual Disney Awards

Rules and Regulations

1. All applicants must be a current member and in good standing with the CSRPO.
2. Each application flying by the same Loft Name will be scored on the current year Old and Young bird seasons combined.
3. Each application must consist of 8 Old birds races with a minimum total flying distance of 2500 miles and 5 young bird races with a minimum total flying distance of 1000 miles.
4. Applicant may enter an application for each competition group he/she competes in. (club, concourse, section, combine, federation). All races submitted must be from the same competition group.
5. Each applicant can only win one award. Applicant will be awarded the highest position earned. If the applicant earns the same position in two divisions the award will be given for the largest competition division.
6. The applicant's official race results must accompany the applicant for verification by the awards chairman.
7. The Walt Disney Award is a perpetual award or trophy that can never be retired as long as the CSRPO is in existence.
8. The average of the number of competing lofts will determine the application division. The loft that accumulates the most points for each division will be declared the winner.
9. The Walt Disney Awards will be computed for six divisions. 5-10 Lofts, 11-25 Lofts, 26-50 Lofts, 51-75 Lofts, 76-100 Lofts and 101+ Lofts.
10. The six divisions will be computed in the following manner:
 - A. The point settings for the first place position for each division is as follows: 5-10 Lofts 5pts, 11-25 Lofts 10pts, 26-50 Lofts 20pts, 51-75 Lofts 30pts, 76-100 Lofts 40pts, and 101+ Lofts 50pts.
 - B. First position will receive the starting points based on application division as stated above. Each following position will receive one less point until all points are exhausted. (Example: If entered in 5-10 Loft division, 5pts for first, 4pts for second, down to 1pt for fifth.) Loft must receive a point in all 13 races to qualify.
11. All applications must be postmarked and mailed to the CSRPO Awards chairman by December 31st of the current year. **ALL WINNERS WILL BE ANNOUNCED AT THE CSRPO BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING IN FEBRUARY.**
12. An award may be given to the outstanding Junior Flyer in the CSRPO, if meritorious. The CSRPO realizes the criteria of rules applying to senior lofts listed above make a junior nearly impossible to qualify. Therefore if no junior loft qualifies according to the above criteria, the Awards Chairman and the CSRPO 3 vice presidents may deem to select a winner, if they feel his/her or race record is one of outstanding achievement.
