He won the prestigious Snowbird Classic and Futurity a record 9 times. There are many pigeon articles written about him over the years. Ed retired from flying actively in 2003 after the death of his brother Pete whom he was very close with. He kept his family of pigeons until today.

Ed touched everyone that he met in some way. His phone would ring all day long with people from all over just to talk to him about anything and everything! All his friends he's had for 20, 30 years or more.

We helped each other through the toughest of times as well as the best of times... From the streets of Amsterdam to the lofts of Leen Boars to the shows in Blackpool to all the great European lofts we did it all.
