Official Show Rules

1. **All birds in section 1 and 2 compete for the CSRPO perpetual Silver Belt Buckle.**
2. All birds in sections 1,2 must be owned and flown by the exhibitor showing them and must have been flown in California. OLR entrants maybe entered in these sections as long as they were entered by the exhibitor/breeder and verifiable (if necessary).
3. Record, and diploma birds must have been clocked and appear on an official race report for the class entered. Sections 1 and 2 must be within the last flying season. 2025. Section 3 flown any year. ***For sections 1-3 Please fill out race portion of the show entry form accordingly. Or have race records available or verifiable via eWinspeed.
4. Sections 1-3 are judged to a standard. These birds need to be perfect, or nearly so.
5. Birds with lice or mites anywhere in the show are automatically disqualified.
6. All birds must be checked in by 9:30am Saturday 1/24/2026
7. Judging will begin at 10 am on Saturday 1/24/2026
8. Ribbons or equivalent will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place birds in each class. Awards will be awarded to all section Winners.
9. Only CSRPO Judges will be judging sections 1 and 2.
10. Judges will not judge in any class or section in which they have birds entered.
11. Entry fees MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY FORM. Entry Fee is \$3.00 per bird. Junior Flyer Entry Fee \$2.00 per bird.
12. All birds will be monitored for sickness. Any sick bird will be disqualified without refund.
13. Once entered, only the bird owner and show committee will be allowed to handle the birds.
14. All exhibitors must be in good standing with the CSRPO.
15. National regulation seamless bands are required on all birds. All non-seamless bands must be removed. Electronic race bands will be accepted.
16. Sections 4 and 5 will be judged non-standard. Non-Standard means that pin holes, broken or nicked flights, flat heads, dented keels, ordinary faults are okay. The judge uses his/her own criteria to select the winners.
17. Protests must be presented to the CSRPO Show Chairman. He and his committee's ruling will be final.
18. All entrants shall abide by the rules. Limited talking to the Judges during judging. Judges will engage in general topics about what they are observing and may answer general questions to enhance the experience for all participants.
